THE COUNTY OF DEVON (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION) (CORONAVIRUS COMMUNITY RESTRICTION) (HIGH STREET INCLUDING THE NARROWS, CASTLE STREET AND SOUTH STREET, TOTNES) NOTICE 2021

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC & PARKING

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL hereby give NOTICE that:

On **SUNDAY 3 JANUARY 2021**
and **SUNDAY 10 JANUARY 2021** (both dates inclusive)

Between the hours of **09:00** and **13:00**

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed or wait on the sections of Affected Roads.

Roads affected -

HIGH STREET INCLUDING THE NARROWS FROM THE JUNCTION WITH PLYMOUTH ROAD TO THE JUNCTION WITH STATION ROAD

CASTLE STREET FROM THE JUNCTION WITH NORTH STREET TO THE JUNCTION WITH HIGH STREET

SOUTH STREET FROM THE JUNCTION WITH LEECHWELL LANE TO THE JUNCTION WITH HIGH STREET

COLLINS ROAD FROM THE JUNCTION WITH HIGH STREET TO A POINT OUTSIDE THE FORGE

The alternative, signed, route for vehicles will be via - BRIDGETOWN OR CORONATION ROAD, A385, A381 WESTERN BYPASS, CISTERN STREET, THE LAMB, HEATH WAY, ST KATHERINE'S WAY, THE PLAINS AND VICE VERSA
