

The South Hams District Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 198, of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 hereby make the following Order

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the South Hams District Council Parish of Totnes No:949 Tree Preservation Order 2017

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order "the authority" means the South Hams District Council.

(2) In this Order any reference to a numbered section is a reference to the section so numbered in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and any reference to a numbered regulation is a reference to the regulation so numbered in the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation) (England) Regulations 2012.

Effect

- 3. (1)Subject to article 4, this Order takes effect provisionally on the date on which it is made. (2) Without prejudice to subsection (7) of section 198 (power to make tree preservation Orders) or subsection (1) of section 200 (tree preservation orders: Forestry Commissioners) and, subject to the exceptions in regulation 14, no person shall -
 - (a) cut down, top, lop, uproot, wilfully damage or wilfully destroy; or
 - (b) cause or permit the cutting down, topping, lopping, uprooting, wilful damage or wilful destruction of,

any tree specified in Schedule 1 to this Order, except with the consent of the authority in accordance with regulations 16 and 17, or of the Secretary of State in accordance with regulation 23, and, where such consent is given subject to conditions, in accordance with those conditions.





- John Pattern	proposed membership list is at Annex A].	Cllrs Barker and Sweett both said that they would do any tasks asked of them but did not wish to be members of the Group. Both felt that they did not have the necessary time or skills required to devote to the Group. Cllr M Adams would be part of the membership and due to a pecuniary interest would absent herself from any discussions or work involving the Steamer Quay.
a constant of the constant of		Cllr Paine expressed concern that the wider membership of the Group should only be considered once the tasks are identified. Cllr R Adams set out that she saw the proposed membership as an initial list and agreed that co-opting people with the skills necessary to carry out specific tasks as work progresses would be required, and all such inclusions would go to Full Council for approval.
		All members would need to complete a declaration of interests to ensure transparency.
***		The RECOMMENDATION to Full Council was for the proposed membership (minus Cllr Barker) to be approved. Voting: 4 (four) votes in favour (Cllrs R Adams, M Adams, Paine and Westacott MBE) and 2 (two) abstentions (Cllrs Barker and Sweett).
2	Administration and running of the TNP Task and Finish Group.	The Group will meet after the Operations Committee is held (usually the third Monday of each month). All meetings will be open to the public and recorded. The meetings will be clerked by the TTC Administrator.
		Cllr Westacott MBE sought assurance that the work carried out to date on the draft TNP would not be wasted, and that the Task and Finish Group would concentrate its efforts in reviewing the comments received from the public consultation in order to revise the draft policies as required. Cllr R Adams confirmed this to be the role of the Task and Finish Group.
		Devon Communities have been approached to run a training session on Neighbourhood Planning which will cover aspects such as policy writing, policy planning, community engagement and meeting the inspection criteria. The potential dates (22 nd , 23 rd or 24 th January 2018) for delivery

		will be circulated to all members of the Task and Finish Group and all TTC Councillors to identify a date that will be best attended.

- 5. <u>Parking Group progress report</u>: JH to organise the holding of a public meeting to consider on-street issues and charging policy. JH to discuss with DCC. Particular issues in Jubilee Road and Plymouth Road where there are no current parking restrictions.
- 6. <u>Bob the Bus report</u>: SH reported that matters were progressing slowly with SHDC in respect of the new HQ for BtB on the Industrial Estate.

SH reported on the Govt consultation on 'unfair competition' for school contracts and call for 'trained and licensed drivers' at a cost of £1000/driver

likely to particularly hurt smaller CT operators. The matter had been raised in Parliament and the Govt was surprised by adverse response.

The barrier recently erected by SHDC at Follaton had resulted in difficulties and these had been partially resolved following a site meeting. Members of the Forum agreed that SHDC's Follaton car park should be classified as a public car park and be regulated.

SH reported on preparations for the Christmas shopping park and ride, including better signage and increased usage. SH will report on numbers at the next meeting.

7. Redworth Junction proposal:

JBrn proposal for a new roundabout layout favouring pedestrians and cyclists went before the recent HATOC meeting and was introduced and proposed by JH. The proposal received support and was referred to DCC's corporate scrutiny for further consideration. JH and JBrn were thanked for progressing this matter.

8. Reports were provided by Town, District and County Councillors

9. Any Other Business:

JB is to circulate a copy of the Baltic Wharf S106 Agreement to those attending and in particular that part dealing with the transport provision. This matter is to be the subject of discussion at the next meeting.

SH raised the matter of parking on pavements and there being no relevant Traffic Regulation Order in the centre of Totnes. He said there was a need for a controlled parking order in the town centre. JH is to discuss with Mike Jones of DCC and report back.
