TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIANS

NOTICE is hereby given that Devon County Council has made the above titled order.

From **MONDAY 3 JANUARY 2022**
for a maximum of 18 months

Anticipated Finish **FRIDAY 28 JANUARY 2022**

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed and no person shall proceed on foot on the sections of Affected Roads except for access to land or premises on or adjacent to those length of roads.

FOOTPATHS FROM HAYES CLOSE TO FURZE GARDENS, TOTNES

The alternative, signed, route for vehicles will be via -
ELM WALK, RUSH WAY, FOOTPATHS FROM HAYES CLOSE TO FURZE GARDENS,
ELMHIRST DRIVE, WESTON LANE, AND VICE VERSA

**EXCAVATE AND PROVIDE PEDESTRIAN ACCESS RAMPS AND RESURFACING
STEP TREADS, PLUS TWO SECTIONS OF DROPPED KERBS**
