

Green Travel Coordinator: Annual Report 2022

Totnes & District Traffic and Transport Forum

- **Appointment of new GTC**

The previous Green Travel Coordinator left the role in August 2021 and a new GTC was appointed at the end of November 2021. Totnes Town Council took the opportunity to amend the GTC job description slightly. The priorities moving forward are to focus on projects that are achievable within the contract time (end date March 2023).

- **Current projects**

The previous GTC was working on a variety of different schemes. A list of these can be found in the following Excel sheet: [Scheme Implementation Plan](#).

Work continues on these although how they each should be prioritised is currently being considered. Focus will partly be on updating the Transport Strategy and there are also new projects that are being considered. This will be discussed with the Forum.

- **Traffic & Transport Forum Terms of Reference**

Amended Terms of Reference have been proposed and will be considered at the AGM. Key changes are for meetings to be held every three months with interim sessions between these if needed, and the addition of a code of conduct.

- **New Facebook page**

Due to technical issues, TTC no longer have access to the Green Travel Totnes Facebook page. A new page is being created and will replace the old one. Facebook has been asked to delete the previous version. There is also a new logo being created to be more in line with the TTC logo.

- **Launch of public consultation**

Devon County Council has proposed traffic calming measures for Totnes Fore Street. These measures have been put out to public consultation via a survey and in-person event in February. The consultation will run until 01 March. It is proposed that the

Steering Group discusses these suggested measures at an interim session in February.

- **Newsletters**

These will resume shortly, most likely in February.
