1. INTERMENTS

Undertakers to be responsible for grave digging and back filling.

Please note: when back filling allow extra soil for setting/sinkage.

2. EXCLUSIVE RIGHT OF BURIAL IN EARTHEN GRAVES

For the exclusive right of burial:

(a) In an earthen grave 8' long x 4' wide x 3' 9" deep (Single)	618.00
(b) In an earthen grave 8' long x 4 wide x 7'6" deep (Double)	924.00
(c) Cremated Remains	388.00
(d) Choice of plot – additional fee	472.00
(e) Transfer of Deed of Grant – administration fee (discretionary)	70.00

3. SCATTERING OF ASHES

For the scattering of ashes:

(a) In the designated areas

4. MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES AND INSCRIPTIONS

For the right to erect or place on a grave:

(a) A flat stone, headstone or ledger monument	388.00
(b) A footstone not exceeding 2' in height measured from the ground or 1' 6" in width	388.00
(c) Kerbstones or border stones enclosing a space not exceeding 8' x 3 (Not permitted in Cemetery Extension)	388.00
(d) A vase not exceeding 1' 6" in height and 6" x 6" in width Please note: vase must be of stone or similar so as not to cause danger to the contractor when strimming grass around the grave	132.00
(e) For the right to place on a grave 3' x 2' (Garden of Rest), in respect of which the exclusive right of burial has been granted, a flat stone level with the ground, tablet or small wedge	174.00

(f) For each additional inscription	No fee
(g) Memorial Tree (Plaque and inscription)	POA
(h) Memorial benches – administration fee	POA

5. GARDEN OF REST MEMORIALS

A slab 24" x 18" x 2" maximum is permitted, on which a Cremated Remains tablet is allowed to be placed as per plan. Any other design must be referred to the Town Council office for prior approval.

Please note:

- (i) All the above stated fees are for parishioners of Totnes. Fees are double for non-parishioners.**
- (ii) From 1st April 2020 where a former parishioner's death has occurred whilst residing in a nursing home outside of Totnes, but they had been resident in Totnes within 3 years of death, single fees will be charged. Proof of address and dates must be provided for this discretionary reduction to apply (for example bank statement, council tax or utility bill).**
- (iii) Any memorials placed in the cemetery without Council approval are liable to be removed at the expense of the person responsible for placing the unauthorised memorial.**
- (iv) All graves in the cemetery extension must be level with the ground and have a headstone only.**
- (v) Our fees do not include grave digging. All income is used towards the grass cutting and upkeep of the cemetery year on year.**
